PACKING TIPS

1. Label your gear. . put your name on everything.

2. Avoid loose items or open bags/bins...gear in vehicles is often just a big pile.

3. Food shold be in coolers and bins (not loose bags).

4. If you need to borrow a pack/cooler/bin or other gear, ask the Quartermaster.

PARENTS: Know your Scout's limitations when it comes to packing and caring for equipment. Trust the Scout to do it, but also verify what they've done.

RULES FOR TROOP GEAR

Many scouts bring their own tents to outings, or scouts may borrow a troop tent. If you need to borrow gear, please ask the Quartermaster.

- No cots are allowed in troop tents.
- No food is allowed in troop tents.
- No use of insect repellant in/around troop tents.
- No flame should be used in/around ANY tent.
- A borrowed troop tent shall be setup at home to dry, and shall be returned to the troop. Missing or broken gear must be reported to the Quartermaster.
